Sing and play musically with increasing confidence and control developing their accuracy, fluency, control and expression

Improvise and compose rhythmic patterns, verses and chorus using musical notation.

Listen and recall sounds with increasing aural memory

Appreciate and understand a range of live and recorded music from different traditions, composers and musicians and develop an understanding of the history of music

Use digital technologies to compose, edit and refine pieces of music.

Identify the beat of a pitch, duration, dynamics, tempo, timbre, texture, structure and appropriate musical notations.
